

Regulations for the Establishment of Collegiate Committee on Interdisciplinary and Innovative Development of International College at I-Shou University

Adopted by the College Affairs Council on January 6, 2021
and promulgated with the consent from the President dated
on January 10, 2021

- Article 1 The Regulations for the Establishment of Collegiate Committee on Interdisciplinary and Innovative Development of International College at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations") are made by the International College (hereinafter referred to as "the College") to form the Collegiate Committee on Interdisciplinary and Innovative Development (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") to shoulder the responsibility for planning and facilitating the interdisciplinary and innovative development of collegiate affairs and improving teaching quality at the College.
- Article 2 The Committee is responsible for:
1. deliberating the interdisciplinary and innovative development of the College; and
 2. deliberating any other issues relating to the interdisciplinary and innovative development of the College.
- Article 3 The Dean of the College shall hold the chairmanship of the Committee, and the Committee shall have four members. The Dean of the College shall nominate department chairs (or institute/program directors) or faculty members to serve as committee members. Committee members shall serve a one-year term and may be reappointed.
- Article 4 The Committee meets at least once every academic year. Extraordinary sessions may be convened if necessary. Experts or specialists from within or outside the University may be invited to attend committee meetings for an exchange of views as participants without the power to vote.
- Article 5 A quorum of at least half of the total membership will be required to validate a committee meeting, and a resolution shall not be adopted unless at least half of the members attending vote in favor of the proposal.
- Article 6 Matters not mentioned herein, if any, shall be subject to the applicable regulations and

rules of the University.

Article 7 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the College Affairs Council and ratified by the President.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of the Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
