

#### **Self-catering Accommodation**

- Student accommodation en-suite single room inside ENU campus

## **Program Fee**

Program Fee is listed below according to the total number of enrolled students:

If we have 10-20 students: GBP2400 (approx. NTD100,080)

If we have 21-30 students: GBP2010 (approx. NTD83,800)

If we have more than 30 students: GBP1850 (approx. NTD77,100)
