Regulations for the Establishment of Bilingual University Promotion Committee of International College at I-Shou University

Adopted by the College Affairs Council on November 18, 2021, and promulgated with the consent from the President dated on December 1, 2021

- Article 1 The college-level Bilingual University Promotion Committee (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") is established by the International College (hereinafter referred to as "the College") with the aim of facilitating and practicing bilingual education, improving students' English skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing and faculty members' EMI skills, and broadening students and faculty members' international perspective.
- Article 2 The Committee is responsible for:
 - 1. deliberating and facilitating bilingual education programs;
 - 2. reviewing the budgets for bilingual education programs;
 - 3. implementing and monitoring bilingual education programs and compiling performance reports; and
 - 4. handling other affairs in relation to bilingual education programs.
- Article 3 The Committee comprises several members, including the Dean of the College, chairs of the departments under the College, and teacher representatives. The Dean of the College holds the chairmanship of the Committee.
- Article 4 Committee members shall meet at least once every semester, and an extraordinary session may be called whenever necessary. Scholars and experts from within or outside the University may be invited to attend committee meetings as participants without the power to vote.
- Article 5 The Dean's Office of the College is responsible for the administrative affairs of the Committee.
- Article 6 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the College Affairs Council and ratified by the President.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of the Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
