

Microcredit Liberal Arts Education of International College

Adopted on October 11, 2017 at the third meeting of the
Executive Board Meeting in the first semester of the

To equip students with interdisciplinary learning skills, the International College enacts this microcredit general education (general education passport) regulation. Students who have taken part in the following courses and activities for a minimum of 36 hours before graduation are eligible to waive one 2-credit liberal arts course of the International College.

- I. Library Instruction: One hour spent on the Library Instruction will be recognized as one hour of liberal arts education.
- II. Activities held by the Office of International and Cross-Strait Affairs: For both on- and off-campus activities, one hour spent will be recognized as one hour of liberal arts education but up to two hours per activity.

Upon completion of a total of 36 hours in the above mentioned activities, students are eligible to apply for credit waiving for one 2-credit liberal arts course (i.e., general education passport) to be reviewed and approved by the International College. This regulation is effective from the second semester of Academic Year 2017.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as the interpretation of the language or terms of the above content, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
